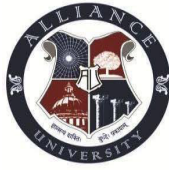

- All costs associated with the International Exchange Programs such as travel, boarding, lodging, insurance, tuition fee (if applicable), and related expenses will be additional and shall be borne by the student.
- Candidates who wish to pay the fees in foreign currency can do so by remitting the foreign currency equivalent in INR based on exchange rate then prevailing.
- NRI fee is applicable for the full duration of the course for candidates who have pursued and completed their last qualifying exam from outside India and for candidates who have applied under NRI Category.
- All students are required to pay a refundable caution deposit of ₹10,000 along with the first instalment of tuition fees.
- All students are required to pay ₹3,000 towards the membership of Alliance Alumni Association and ₹1,500 towards the convocation fees along with the first instalment of tuition fees.
- Students are advised to pay fees above ₹10,000 via RTGS/ NEFT/Online/ DD.
